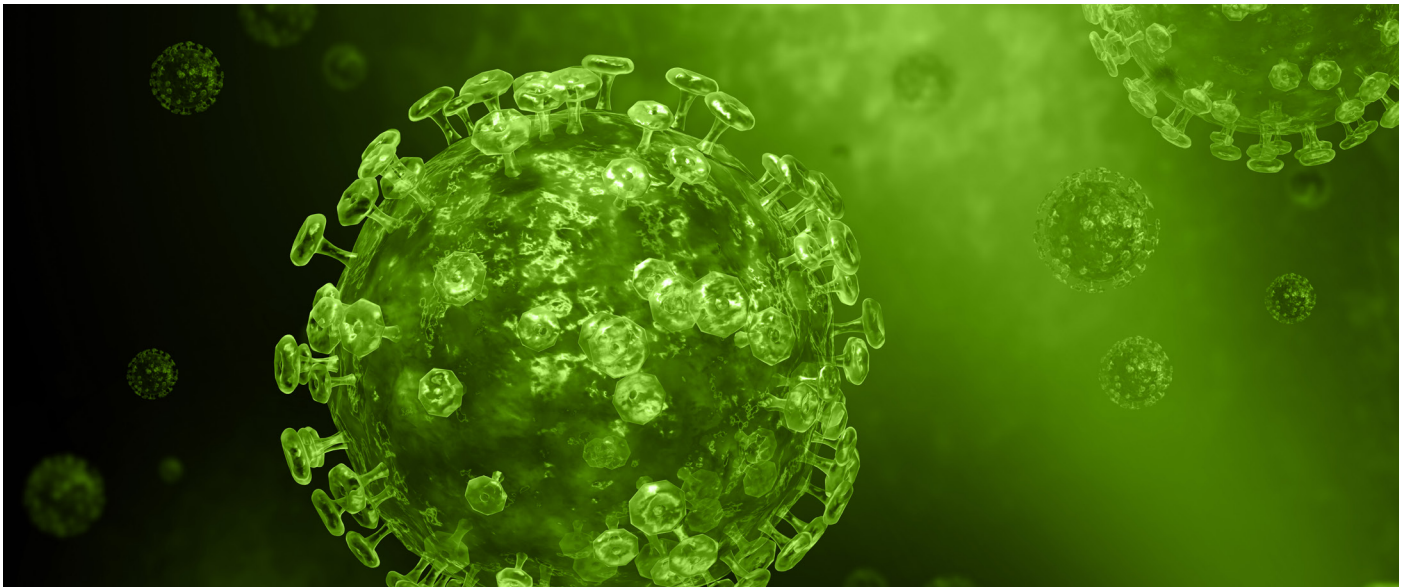


Viroclinics-DDL Team to Support COVID-19 New Drug Investigations
